MEWA Rules and Regulations Definitions To Be Added (July 8, 2023)

The following definitions will be added to the Rules and Regulations. They are often referred to in describing the water system but are not included in the Rules and Regulations definitions. These definitions will be added to the Rules and Regulations, section IC1, Definitions. This is not an amendment to the Rules and Regulations but a clarification.

Water Main: The main water line buried in the road that carries water from the well tanks to the Laterals to homes.

Lateral: water line from Water Main to home.

NOTE: Maintaining the Lateral from the Water Main to the home is the financial responsibility of the owner. The Lateral is in two parts:

- 1. **Water Main to Curb Stop**: This section of the Lateral is installed by MEWA for the current set fee to be paid by the owner.
- 2. **Curb Stop to Home**: This section of the Lateral is installed by the owner's certified contractor at the owner's expense.

Curb Stop: The valve, installed by MEWA, in the Lateral between the Water Main and home.

Augmentation Plan: The legal and binding agreement with the state of Colorado on how much water Pan Ark is allowed to use and restrictions on how it is to be used.
