## **Properties with Hydrants:**

- 1. Certificates with Hydrants on the property **ARE NOT** transferable (see #2).
- 2. Hydrants MAY be deactivated AT OWNERS EXPENSE.
- 3. Hydrants <u>WITHOUT</u> curb stops must have a <u>CURB STOP</u> installed <u>PRIOR</u> to beginning construction and <u>HYDRANT REMOVED</u>. Cost is the responsibility of the property owner, PAYMENT IN ADVANCE, and work must be completed by the <u>MEWA's approved contractor</u>.
- 4. HYDRANTS ON A VACANT LOT <u>DO NOT</u> INDICATE A VAILD WATER CERTIFICATES AND <u>DO NOT GUARANTEE</u> THAT THE HYDRANTS IS ATTACHED TO THE MAIN LINE.

Certificates <u>CANNOT</u> be transferred to lots that <u>DO NOT</u> have a water line in the road in front of the property.

Certificate number <u>MUST MATCH</u> the lot number which the home occupies. In the case of <u>Lot</u> <u>Consolidation</u> the <u>Membership ID is CHANGED TO the new lot number</u>.

The Board, pursusant to the power and authority granted by the Rules and Regulations, shall have the power to assess additional fees, charges, rates, penalties and costs as the Board determines appropriate.
